



# What is the HealthyCare Card?

The HealthyCare Card (HCC) is a program of the Healthy Community Network (HCN) in which eligible members are able to receive medical services and medications at a discount. The HealthyCare Card is **not** insurance nor a qualified health plan or credible coverage.

If you are eligible for health insurance through federal or state programs or through your job, you **must** apply for this first. Even with commercial health insurance, you may still be eligible for assistance through the HCC.

**To be able to receive HCC discounts, services must be given by healthcare providers and facilities who accept HCC. Some doctors and other providers who give care at healthcare facilities are not part of HCN and they may not discount their charges or charges may vary based on the policy of each provider. Please check with the staff at each office.**

Facilities that **do** accept HCC are: WellSpan Health including Gettysburg Hospital and York Hospital, Ephrata Community Hospital, Good Samaritan Hospital, Hanover Hospital, and Memorial Hospital.

## **Services that are discounted:**

Listed below are some of the major services which are **discounted** by those who **accept** HCC (after insurance):

- Office visits
- Immunizations, Lab tests, X-rays, MRIs
- Speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy
- Family planning, maternity services, mammograms
- Diabetes education, Tobacco education
- Mental health services, Weight loss classes
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Basic health screenings
- Preventative services
- Stays in the hospital (if not eligible for Medical Assistance)
- Home health & hospice care
- ReadyCare visits
- Emergency room visits

## **What is Not Discounted:**

Services HealthyCare Card does **not** discount include:

- Bariatric surgery
- Infertility
- Cosmetic surgery
- Ambulance charges
- Routine dental care
- Check with your provider about co-pays from **other** insurance
- Acupuncture
- Chiropractors
- Prosthetics
- Hospital beds
- Electric wheel chairs & Lifts
- Eye care and eye glasses

## **Dental Options:**

- York Hospital Dental Center – HCC members receive discounts on most general dentistry services. Discounts may vary by procedure. Please call 851-2655 for details and to make an appointment.
- Hoodner Dental Center - HCC members receive discounts on most general dentistry services. Discounts may vary by procedure. Please call 812-7860 for details and to make an appointment.
- Family First Health Dental Center has a reduced fee schedule for uninsured. For more information call York 845-8617, Hanover 717-632-9052, or Gettysburg 717-337-9400.

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### Chronic Disease Support

HealthyCare Card holders also receive help for certain chronic diseases such as diabetes or asthma. You will get information in the mail or receive a call from a nurse in medical management who can talk with you about your condition. If you have questions, please call 1-800-749-4194. In cases where a patient's disease may be of a serious nature, Healthy Community Network may arrange for care management services.

**Remember:**

- Please present all insurance cards each time you are seen at your medical provider.
- The HealthyCare Card is a discount program that works with most medical health insurance plans; if you are struggling to pay the insurance premiums, do not drop primary insurance, please call us first for assistance.
- Notify HCN when changes are made to your primary insurance, this could affect your eligibility with HCN.
